Maximilian Kolbe was born in Poland in 1894. He became a Franciscan priest in 1918 and worked on religious publications and Catholic press productions. He later worked on the missions in Japan founding a monastery on the outskirts of Nagasaki. Due to poor health he returned to Poland in 1936. In 1941 he was arrested and imprisoned by the Nazis in Auschwitz. He volunteered to die in place of another prisoner who had a wife and family. Maximilian Kolbe died on 14 August 1941. He was declared a saint on 10 October 1982. His feast day is on Monday of this coming week.
