Saint Eoghan

St Eoghan (Eugene) whose feast day is on next Wednesday is one of the lesser known Irish saints. He lived in the sixth century and was abducted by pirates and taken to Britain. He escaped back to Ireland where he founded a church at Kilnamanagh (Ceall na Manach) near Tallaght. He later founded a church at Ardstraw in County Tyrone (Tír Eoghan). He is now patron, under the Anglicised form of Eugene, of the diocese of Derry. His feast day falls on the 23 August each year.
