This weekend as we celebrate Karen Jackson's Months Memory Mass her family's greatest wish is that her death would inspire hundreds and maybe even thousands of people to become organ donors in her memory. There are organ donor cards on the tables in each of the four churches in the parish and we ask all of you, especially the younger generation, to take a card home with you, discuss it with your family and if at all possible agree to become an organ donor yourself and also to encourage other people to do so. All you have to do is to sign the back of the donor card and get your next of kin to witness it. Right now there are over 2,000 people on dialysis in Ireland waiting for a kidney transplant and many others waiting for the gift other organs. Successful transplants of the kidney, heart, lung, liver and pancreas are being carried out in the country and these operations are giving a whole new lease of life to people. There is an information sheet along with each donor card. So please bring it home with you, read the information sheet and if at all possible do agree to become a donor - and better still encourage others to do so too.
