Review of Child Safeguarding Practice in Kilmore

The second review of Child Safeguarding practice the diocese of Kilmore was completed in August 2018 by the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church. There were no allegations of abuse having taken place in the diocese in the years since the last Review (2010). Ten allegations of historical abuse - some of them going back to the 1950s - were received since the last Review. All of these were found to have been dealt with appropriately. The report was very positive about Child Safeguarding in the diocese and the leadership given by Bishop Leo O'Reilly and other safeguarding personnel. It concluded that 'The work is underpinned by strong leadership and committed individuals who provide direction, training, time and concern for those children who are entrusted to their care.' Bishop Leo O'Reilly says a sincere thanks and congratulations to all safeguarding personnel at diocesan and parish level for their hard work and commitment.
