Dear Parishioners

You probably have heard the recent relaxation of restrictions. The first is that as from this coming Monday 8 June 2020, up to twenty five people can attend a funeral Mass. The previous limit was ten. The second big change is that, all going well in the meantime, we will be able to have public Masses and other liturgies in our churches from Monday 29 June 2020. This is three weeks earlier than previously stated. Both these developments are great news.

So please God we will be able to have public Masses from the end of June onwards. However, there will still be restrictions on the number of people who can be present in our churches at any one time. We will still need to abide by the physical distancing guidelines in place.

As we mentioned last week will need the help of a new group of people in the parish who are willing to work as stewards, helping people and guiding people in each of the churches, so that people can return to Church in a safe manner and be reassured that best practice is being adhered to at all times. So we need volunteers to help in each church area. Some have volunteered already, but we need others, especially young people to help. If you would like to help in this way please contact either one of us during the next week.

So we are looking forward and preparing to return to Masses in our churches sooner than expected. We will keep you updated on any developments. In the meantime stay safe and keep up the prayers.

On this Sunday, the Feast of the Holy Trinity, Fr Liam will be celebrating Mass in the Cathedral in Cavan. This Mass will be broadcast on RTE News Now at 2pm.

Beatification of Fr Michael McGivney

The announcement was made during the past week that Fr Michael McGivney who was born in the United States in 1852 and died in 1890 is to be beatified. Both of Fr Michael's parents had emigrated from County Cavan, his father Patrick being born in Drumkilly and his mother Mary coming from Castlerahan. His father died when he was young as did several of his siblings and his mother struggled to make ends meet. Because of this childhood experience Fr McGivney had a great love for the poor, for widows and orphans and so he founded the Knights of Columbus to help alleviate their poverty. The Knights of Columbus is now a worldwide organisation and is keeping up the good work started by Fr McGivney. We pray that this man, born of Cavan parents, will soon be canonized a saint.

Kilmore Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock

Was due to take place on next Sunday week 21 June 2020. We will not be travelling to Knock on that day. Instead, pilgrims can join the afternoon ceremonies in Knock from their homes. The schedule for the afternoon will include the praying of the Rosary at 2.30pm, followed by Mass and Benediction at 3pm. In advance of the day, pilgrims may place their petitions online on the Knock Shrine website and these will be placed on the altar for the Mass. Many pilgrims light candles for loved ones and their intentions during their visit to Knock Shrine and this service is also available online. A candle will be lit at the outdoor candelabra for each request received. The pilgrimage will be streamed live on www.knockshrine.ie and Radio Maria (Saorview TV Channel 210) will also broadcast the pilgrimage.
