Please note that the following practices will be in place in order to keep everyone safe and well.

- ❖ Each church will have sanitizer dispensers and appropriate signage in place.
- ❖ There will be no Holy Water in the fonts.
- ❖ All collections will take place in the porch before or after Mass
- ❖ You will collect your own leaflet on the way into Mass and bring it with you at the end of Mass.
- ❖ People must keep physically distant from each other - this means that you will most likely not be able to sit in your normal seat.
- ❖ Family groups may stay together
- ❖ There will be no sign of peace
- ❖ Ushers will help people as enter the church, as they go forward for Communion and as they leave the church.
- ❖ It is recommended that everyone receive Holy Communion on the hand.
- ❖ Priests and Eucharistic ministers will sanitize their hands before and after distributing Holy Communion and they will wear face masks.
