#### Feast of Christ the King

Today, the Feast of Christ the King, is the last Sunday in the liturgical year. Next Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent and it begins the period of preparation for the coming of our Saviour at Christmas time.

There are several issues to be considered before final decisions are made - these include such things as finances, availability of broadband, Wi Fi etc. All three schools in the parish have kindly agreed to let us link in to their broadband, though we need to do further tests before we know if this will work. We are continuing to make progress on this and will keep you informed of any developments.
