Clarification on Baptisms

We received clarification on Baptisms during the past week. Baptisms may go ahead in cases of pastoral necessity. They may take place with only the minimum numbers present - that is the child to be baptized, parents/guardians, two sponsors and the priest. There is a recommendation that there be no social gathering after the baptism.
