New Guidelines For Mass Attendance

Please note that numbers will be restricted in our churches.

Clarification on Baptisms

We received clarification on Baptisms recently. Baptisms may go ahead in cases of pastoral necessity. They may take place with only the minimum numbers present - that is the child to be baptized, parents/guardians, two sponsors and the priest. There is a recommendation that there be no social gathering after the baptism.
