

This Sunday, 25 April, is Good Shepherd Sunday, a day set aside to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. The harvest is great but the labourers are few. On average two of our priests are dying each year with the result that we are fast reaching the stage when some parishes in the diocese will not have a resident priest. But we must not lose heart. We can manage in the future with fewer priests and on this Sunday we pray that lay people, women and men, will rediscover their own baptismal calling to serve their parish communities in a variety of different ways. All the baptized have vocations. All are called by God to live good Christian lives and to put their gifts and talents at the disposal of their local parish community. If we do that then the future will be very bright indeed.
