Public Masses will resume in our churches from tomorrow Monday 10th May. Our first weekend Masses open to the public will be on next weekend 15th and 16th May. Ushers are ready to help with our return to Mass and all protocols are in place. Mass will continue to be on webcam also.

New Guidelines For Mass Attendance

Following new government guidelines it is now clear that from 10 May onwards a limited number of people may attend Masses in our Churches however all must adhere to protocols that are in place. We ask that large numbers do not turn up for weekend Masses. If you do attend Mass you are asked to:

- ❖ Abide by the instructions of the ushers
- ❖ Sanitise your hands as you enter and leave the church
- ❖ Wear a mask both inside and outside the church
- ❖ Keep two metres away from people of other households
- ❖ Note that collections to take place in the porch on the way in
- ❖ Note there will be no holy water in the holy water fonts
- ❖ Note there will be no sign of peace during Mass
- ❖ Receive Communion in the hand.
- ❖ No altar servers until further notice
- ❖ Up to 50 people may attend Funeral Mass
- ❖ Up to 50 people may attend weddings in church
