Easing of Restrictions from Monday

Thankfully, due to the encouraging pandemic situation, restrictions will be eased from this coming Monday. However, we encourage all people to continue to be careful and not put your own health or that of others at risk. From this Monday 7 June 2021:

- . You can have visitors to your home from one other household
- . Restaurants and bars can reopen for outdoor service for groups of up to 6 people
- . Wedding receptions can have up to 25 people in attendance
- . Gyms, swimming pools and leisure centres can reopen for individual training
- . Swimming lessons and classes can take place
- . Outdoor sports matches can take place
- . Cinemas and theatres can reopen
- . Outdoor events can have up to 100 people attend.
- . 200 people can attend venues with capacity of 5000 or more
- . Driver Theory Test Services can partially re-open (25,000 tests per month with related opening of driver test centres)
- . Drive-in cinema and drive-in bingo can take place

St Colum Cille (521-597)

St Colum Cille who is sometimes known by his Latin name Columba is one of the most important native Irish saints. His feast day on next Tuesday 9th June marks the 1500th anniversary of his birth in north Donegal. He became a monk as a young man and studied under St Finian at Clonard. In 1546 he founded a monastery at Derry. In the year 563 he set off with twelve companions to the island of Iona off the coast of Scotland. The monastery he founded there became a centre of missionary outreach to both Scotland and Ireland and Iona became an international place of pilgrimage. Colm Cille was noted for his poetry and book learning, his gentleness and kindness to all human beings and his love of animals, birds and all of God's creation. He died on 9 June in the year 597 and is now regarded as one of the most important Irish born saint.
