Easing of Restrictions

Thankfully, due to the encouraging pandemic situation, restrictions have been eased since last Monday. However, we encourage all people to continue to be careful and not put your own health or that of others at risk. You can now:

- . You can have visitors to your home from one other household
- . Restaurants and bars can reopen for outdoor service for groups of up to 6 people
- . Wedding receptions can have up to 25 people in attendance
- . Gyms, swimming pools and leisure centres can reopen for individual training
- . Swimming lessons and classes can take place
- . Outdoor sports matches can take place
- . Cinemas and theatres can reopen
- . Outdoor events can have up to 100 people attend.
- . 200 people can attend venues with capacity of 5000 or more
- . Driver Theory Test Services can partially re-open (25,000 tests per month with related opening of driver test centres)
- . Drive-in cinema and drive-in bingo can take place

Archbishop Dermot O'Hurley (c.1530-1584)

Next Saturday, 19th June is the feast day of Blessed Dermot O'Hurley, the archbishop of Cashel, who was martyred on 20 June 1584. He was born near Emly in County Tipperary about the year 1530. As a young man he went to Louvain to study philosophy and theology. He was a brilliant student and he continued his studies and lectured in Louvain, Reims and Rome. In 1581 he was appointed Archbishop of Cashel by Pope Gregory XIII. He returned to Ireland at a time when persecution of Catholics was at fever pitch and in October 1583 he was arrested and imprisoned in Dublin castle. He was tortured in prison by burning his feet and legs. See drawing elsewhere in this newsletter. Some time after he was tortured he was sentenced to death by hanging. This sentence was carried out in Dublin early on the morning of 20 June 1584.
