Fr Noel Boylan (1939-2021)

Fr Noel Boylan, who was curate here in Kill from 2010 to 2014, died on Tuesday last. He was born on 19 December 1939. He studied medicine in college and became a G.P. He had a practice in Virginia in County Cavan where he was a much loved doctor. Then when he was in his early fifties he entered the seminary in Waterford to study for the priesthood and was ordained for the diocese of Kilmore on 9 June 1996. He was appointed curate in Killargue in Leitrim that year and was appointed to Bruskey in 2000. In 2005 he was moved to Teemore before coming to Kill in 2010. In 2014 he returned to Bruskey as priest in residence and, due to ill health, retired to Kilnaleck in 2018. He celebrated the Silver Jubilee of his ordination just a week before he died. He was a gentle and good man and did great work both as a doctor and priest. He was buried in Bruskey on Thursday last. May he rest in peace.
