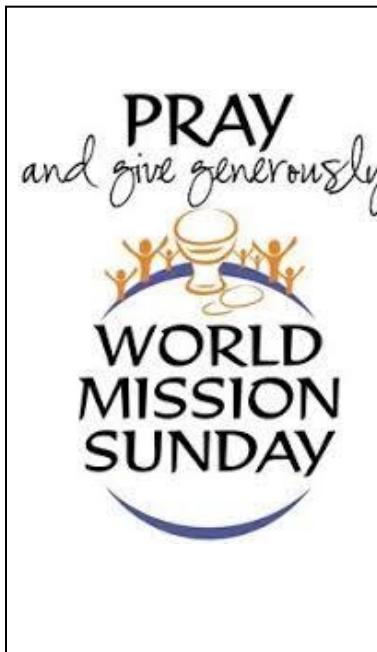

### Lifting of Restrictions

The Government has lifted more of the Covid-19 restrictions on Fri. last 22<sup>nd</sup> October. There is now no regulation for physical distancing and there is no limit on the number of people attending religious or civil ceremonies. So we will have all seats in our churches available for use once more. However, it is important that we realize that the virus is still with us and that we must continue with good practice, we must be sensible and careful in order to prevent the virus spreading. The following guidelines will remain in place:

- ❖ Collections will continue to be taken up at church doors.
- ❖ There will be no Holy Water in the fonts.
- ❖ Sanitisers will remain in place and people are asked to use them.
- ❖ People will be asked to continue to wear masks in church.
- ❖ People will be asked to use all the seats in the church and not crush in beside people from other households.
- ❖ People will be asked to continue receiving Holy Communion in hands.
- ❖ There will be no sign of peace & no handshaking at removals/Funerals.
- ❖ People are asked to keep their distance from other family groups when entering and leaving the Church and receiving Holy Communion.
