### Lifting of Restrictions

The Government may lift most of the Covid-19 restrictions on next Fri. 22<sup>nd</sup> October. If they do these changes will mean that there will be no requirement for physical distancing and that there will be no limit on people attending religious or civil ceremonies. So when these changes take place it is planned to have all seats in our churches available for use once more. However, it is hoped that people will be responsible and continue to act in a sensible and careful way so as not to spread the virus. The following guidelines will remain in place for the time being:

- ❖ Collections will continue to be taken up at church doors.
- ❖ There will be no Holy Water in the fonts.
- ❖ Sanitisers will remain in place and people are asked to use them.
- ❖ People will be asked to continue to wear masks in church.
- ❖ People will be asked to use all the seats in the church and not crush in beside people from other households.
- ❖ There will be no sign of peace & no handshaking at removals/Funerals.
