It is a major task and will take time and we are working in conjunction with the Heritage Council of Ireland, Cavan Heritage officer and Cavan County Council. In accordance with the guidance of the Heritage Council of Ireland we will, in the coming weeks, be putting some sheep in to the graveyard to eat down the huge amount of foliage and growth in a way that will not do any environmental damage.
