Christmas Masses

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic which is still with us we will not be able to have large numbers of people at our Christmas Masses. We want you to be aware of the situation in advance so that you will not be disappointed if you turn up for Mass and find that no more people can safely be accommodated in the church. To avoid that happening please read the following guidelines which we have in place:

- ❖ We remind people, especially those who are vulnerable, that the obligation to attend Mass does not apply during the pandemic.
- ❖ Webcams have already been installed in Bunnoe, Drung and Kill Churches. The webcam link for churches in the parish is www.churchtv.ie
- ❖ We encourage people to link in to Christmas Mass on webcam or on television and to consider not attending Christmas Eve or Christmas Day Masses.
- ❖ Instead we recommend that you go to Mass sometime in the week before Christmas or in the week after Christmas when numbers attending will be smaller.
- ❖ In order to prevent large crowds gathering for any one Mass we have put on extra Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas day. See the details overleaf.
- ❖ We will, in all, have eight Christmas Masses in the parish. If you would like to attend one of these please consider going to a Christmas morning Mass rather than the one on Christmas Eve.
- ❖ We ask also that you consider attending Mass in one of the bigger Churches.
- ❖ We encourage families to visit the crib and to pray in the church at quiet times in the days before and after Christmas
- ❖ We are very grateful to all our ushers who have done great work keeping us safe at our Masses throughout the year. We ask you to please listen carefully to their advice and to abide by it.
- ❖ We hope that you all have an enjoyable, safe and blessed Christmas.
