St Ita

St Ita whose feast day falls on next Saturday 15th January, is the best known Irish female saint after St Brigid. Because of this she is known as the foster mother of the saints of Ireland. St Ita, who was born in the early 6th century, was known in Irish as Íde. She founded a monastery in Killeedy (Cill Íde) in County Limerick and Kilmeedy in County Limerick is also named after her as are four holy wells in the county. One of the accounts of her life, which was written about 1175 AD states that St Maedhóg, the Cavan born saint who is also called Aidan, visited St Ita in Killeedy. St Ita died in the year 570AD.
