### St Ita

St Ita whose feast day falls on next Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> January, is the best known Irish female saint after St Brigid. Because of this she is known as the foster mother of the saints of Ireland. St Ita, who was born in the early 6<sup>th</sup> century, was known in Irish as Íde. She founded a monastery in Killeedy (Cill Íde) in County Limerick and Kilmeedy in County Limerick is also named after her as are four holy wells in the county. One of the accounts of her life, which was written about 1175 AD states that St Maedhóg, the Cavan born saint who is also called Aidan, visited St Ita in Killeedy. St Ita died in the year 570AD.

### St Maedhóg

St Maedhóg (pronounced Mogue), whose feast day is on 30<sup>th</sup> January, was born on the lake island of Port in the parish of Templeport about the year 550AD. His name was Aedh but he was known in Irish as Mo Aedh Óg (My young Aedh) and with time that became shortened to Maedhóg. Because his name in Irish was Aedh he became known in Latin as Aedanus and this explains why Maedhóg is now called Aidan in many places. St Aidan's Comprehensive School, and many other schools and churches which are named after St Aidan are in fact named after St Maedhóg, one of Cavan's most famous saints. Maedhóg went to Wales where he studied under St David and then he returned to Ferns in County Wexford where he founded a church and monastery. St Maedhóg is the patron saint of the diocese of Ferns. He was known in both Wales and Ferns as Aidan. Devotion to St Maedhóg was strong in Templeport and Drumlane parishes here in County Cavan and in Rossinver in County Leitrim. He died in the year 626AD.
