Diocesan fundraising campaign for cathedral renovations

We are extremely privileged to have such an iconic cathedral in our Diocese. Last year it celebrated its 80th anniversary and Fr. Kevin Fay along with his parish council took on the challenge of renovating it to ensure it is a safe, welcoming and comfortable place to worship. Works are completed and I suggest you visit the cathedral to witness it in all its splendour.

Despite the completion of the cathedral renovation, there is still a financial cost for the works to be paid. Father Kevin has raised €1.8 million of his €2 million goal. It is testament to parishioners and diaspora that this project is succeeding. The fundraising campaign is now at crucial stage and Bishop Hayes has asked all the faithful in the Diocese to consider making a contribution to this landmark campaign.

This weekend, March 11th and 12th, there will be information packs available at the back of church after Mass. I ask that you take one if interested and make a sacrificial donation that is right for you.
