Bunnoe Summer Festival: Festival will take place from Friday 14th July to Sunday 16th July. Details to follow.

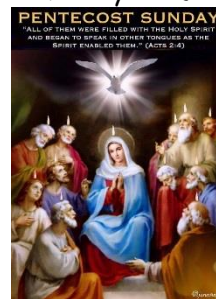
