**Blessing of Graves** The Blessing of the graves in Bunnoe & Magherintemple will take place on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> September. Mass will be at 11.00am.

**Irish Blood Transfusion Service – Cootehill:** Our stocks of O- A- and B- are very low following the last Bank Holiday Weekend so we are hoping you may be able to help us increase attendance for our Blood Donation Clinic coming soon to the Errigal County House Hotel, Cootehill. I'm not sure if you seen/ heard the RTE 6-1 news last Monday our CEO Orla O'Brien was on asking Donors to make a special effort to attend over the next 5 weeks in particular because they were close to an Amber Alert. An Amber Alert means the hospitals are notified & requested to reduce elective surgeries so we are really hoping to avoid this. Please find attached an A4 poster ahead of our Blood Donation Clinic in the coming weeks to Cootehill. Please include this notice in your parish bulletin. Blood Donation clinics are still by appointment so we are asking Donors to ring [1800 222 111](tel:1800222111) to make an appointment.

**Bunnoe Church Committee:** A new Church Committee needs to be formed for Bunnoe as a new new graveyard needs to be developed.
