**Pro Life Prayers-Cavan General Hospital Sun Dec 1st -3 PM** Cavan General Hospital is one of only two maternity hospitals not currently providing an abortion service and it is hoped that Cavan can continue to be a safe sanctuary for life of the unborn. Pro Life Prayers are organised at the gates of Cavan General Hospital on Sunday December 1st at 3 PM. Close by in the hospital grounds is a statue of Saint Joseph patron of families, fathers & expectant mothers. Deacon Andy Brady has kindly agreed to lead prayers. Potential legalisation for euthanasia may also be an issue early in 2025. We will pray for all parents of aborted babies & those who have had miscarriages.
